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Isabella Geriatric Center has announced that as of **Thursday, April 13, 2017** it will be closing **Isabella Care at Home**, it's Certified Home Health Agency (CHHA).

Isabella Care at Home began caring for patients in 2014. A highly competitive environment in a rapidly changing health care setting has necessitated the decision to close the program.

Patients under the care of **Isabella Care at Home** have been notified of this planned closure. Those patients who may require care beyond the closure date will be assisted by Isabella's professional staff in finding another Certified Home Health Agency to continue their care. Isabella's staff will work with each patient, his/her family, physician, insurance company and other agencies to ensure the proper continuation of the care that is needed.

The staff members of **Isabella Care at Home** have been advised of the planned closure and those whose employment will be adversely affected will be offered an opportunity to apply for available positions within the Isabella family of services.

Isabella Geriatric Center, a non-profit, non-sectarian provider of care to older adults, has been serving the greater New York community since 1975. In addition to a 705 bed nursing home, Isabella offers senior housing, short and long-term rehabilitation, an adult day health care program and a licensed home care services agency (LHCSA). In addition, Isabella offers a variety of community based services including a Senior Resource Center, (3) NORC Programs and the Institute for Older Adults – all designed to promote health and independence.
